Paying for Law School

Scholarships: Admitted applicants are *automatically* considered for meritbased Faulkner Law Scholarships. No separate application is necessary.

Military Benefits: Applicants who qualify for military benefits should: (1) obtain a certificate of eligibility through <u>benefits.va.gov</u>. (this process can take up to 30 days) and

Private Lenders: Private education loans, not guaranteed by the federal government, are available through lending institutions and are credit-based. To borrow private funds, apply directly through the lender of your choice.

Federal Loans: Students are eligible to apply for two types of federal loans: **Direct Unsubsidized Loans** and **Direct GradPLUS loans**.

- Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at studentaid.gov or by using the myStudentAid app for iOS and Android.
- 2. Complete the required Entrance Counseling.
- 3. Complete the Subsidized/Unsubsidized <u>Master Promissory Note</u> (MPN).

Federal Direct GradPLUS Loan

- Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at studentaid.gov or by using the myStudentAid app for iOS and Android.
- 2. Complete the <u>Direct PLUS Loan Application for</u> <u>Graduate/Professional Students</u>.
- Complete the <u>PLUS Master Promissory Note</u> (MPN) for Graduate/Professional Students.
